(Reproductive Medicine and fertility) Germany

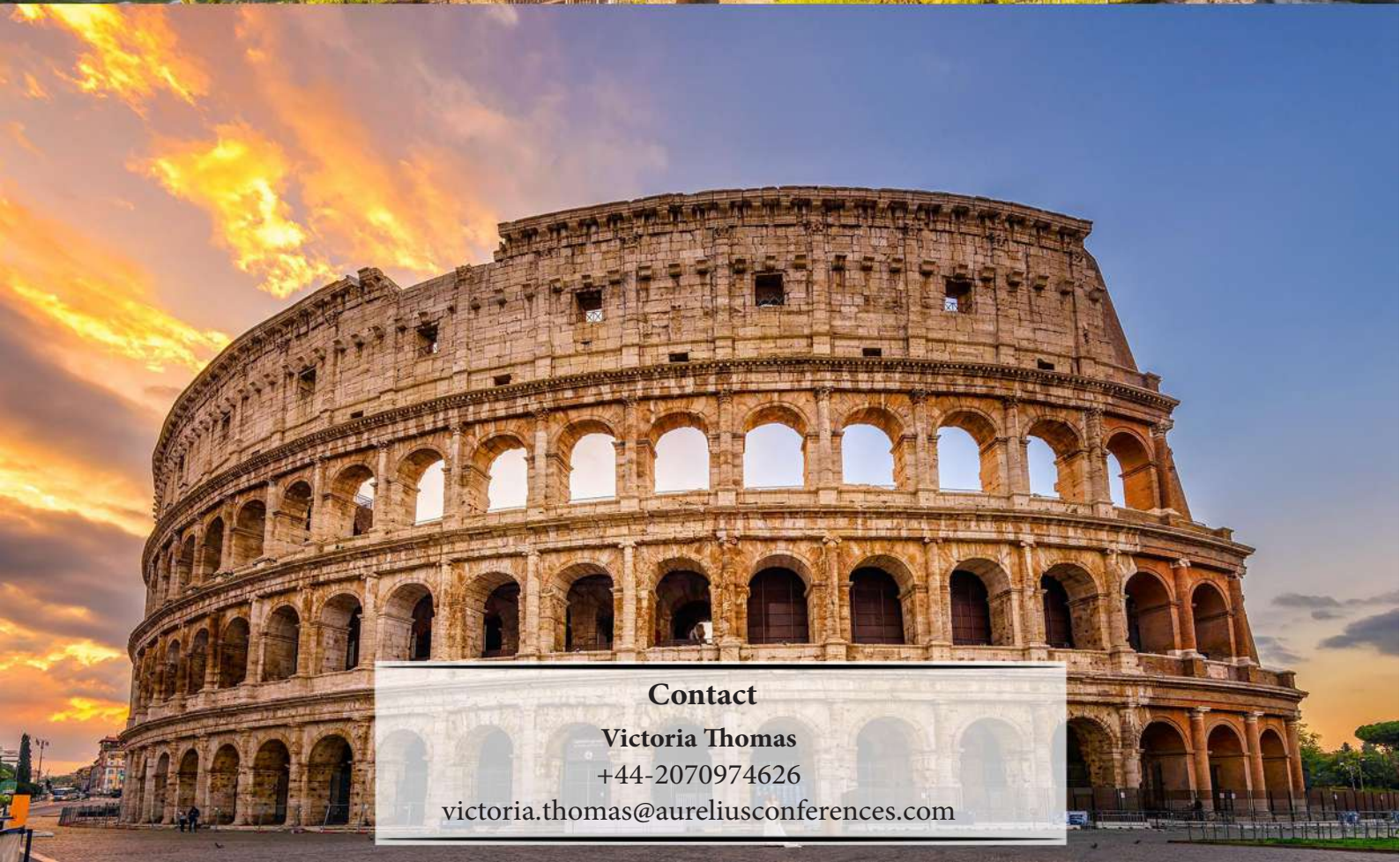
